PROPOSED PLAN FOR DISPLAY STRUCTURES



As a heads-up to you all, this is the current proposed plan for how your work will be displayed. The exhibition areas is made up of two floors; a downstairs office space and an upstairs small hall. Lighting upstairs is limited to free-standing lights.

3D work would be shown either free standing (size dependant), or on the given spaces on the hung structures.

2D work would be either hung along the alcoves of the upstairs area, or be pinned to the wedges on the hung structures.

Publications would be displayed on the shelved wedges on the hung structures. Films would be shown on a group showreel to be projected in the downstairs space, or displayed on the hung structures on Tablets.
